This product consists of a dictionary database plug-in that may be used with **Bible With You** reader in which it will provides pop-up definitions of words in the Bible or may be explored with GMPSOft's **DEPReader** dictionary program.

The dictionaries included in GMPSOft's **Dictionary With You** series are selected to assist you in your studies of the Bible on your PDA by helping you explore the meaning of words used in the Scripture.

Warning: Requires **Bible With You** or **DEPReader** PDA applications.

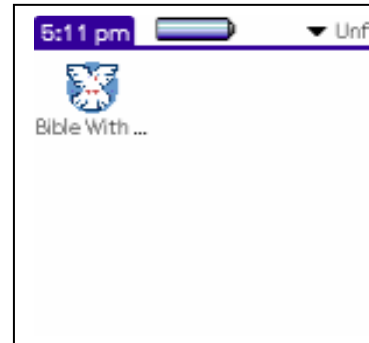
2 Installing this product

Warning: Requires **Bible With You** or **DEPReader** PDA applications.

1. Download and install this product on your device:
 - Install in the RAM or on an expansion card

For help with downloading and the installation, please, read the FAQs at GMPSoft's website: www.gmpsoft.com

2. Launch **Bible With You** or **DEPReader**:
 - Locate the **Bible With You** icon on the Applications screen of your PDA device
 - Tap on the icon to launch the application



3 Product registration

3.1 Licenses

GMPSoft offers the following licenses for using its products:

1. **Trial License** – Includes all the functionality of the **Standard License** plus a trial reminder indication that the product needs to be registered.
2. **Standard License** – Indicates that you have successfully licensed a GMPSoft's product.
3. **Limited License** – Indicates that you have availed of the opportunity for one limited license for a GMPSoft's product. The **Limited License** is free.
4. **Free License** – Indicates that you have licensed a free GMPSoft's product.

3.2 Product Registration

This fully functioning product can be registered with the help of **PADUnlock** file (**PA**lm **D**atabase **U**nlock System). **PADUnlock** is a standard database file (.pdb) containing your registration information for each of the products you have purchased. You receive your **PADUnlock** file after you order a License for a GMPSoft product and register it in our system database.

1. Get your **PADUnlock**:
 - Follow the Unlock Key link in the GMPSoft Sales Confirmation email you have received after the purchase.
 - Click on **GET IT** link in your **Product Info** page.
 - Save the file on your PC

2. Install PADUnlock

- Install **PADUnlock** database in your device's RAM or on the expansion card.

3. Go to the **Registration** form:

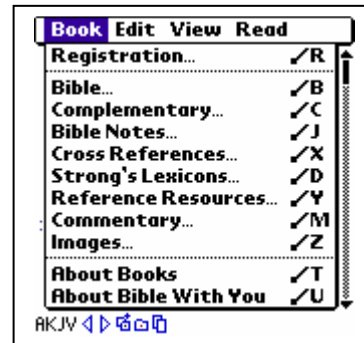
- Launch a GMPSoft product
- Tap on the **Headline** bar or the **Menu** button to display the form menu
- Tap on **Book**
- Tap on **Registration**

Or

- Draw the *Graffiti Menu Command stroke* ✓ and the letter **R** on the silkscreen

Or

- Tap on the **Register** button in the trial reminder form

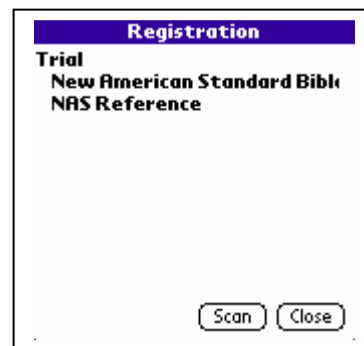


4. Apply your **PADUnlock** registration information:

- Tap on the **Scan** button

GMPSoft products support **PADUnlock** Key protocol and use it to automatically register your products.

Note: The *Trial reminder* form will still appear if there is even one product with a Trial License state.

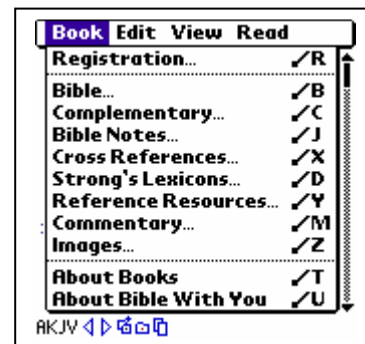
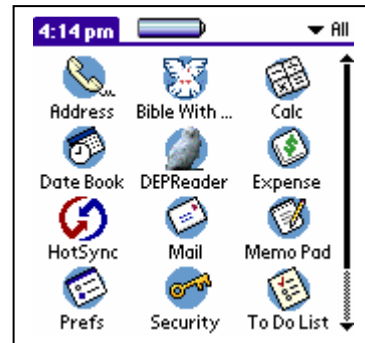


4 Using This Product With Bible With You

4.1 Activation

Get **Bible With You** from: www.gmpsoft.com

1. Launch **Bible With You**:
 - Locate the **Bible With You** icon in the Palm Applications Launcher
 - Tap on the icon to launch the reader
2. Choose **Reference Resources...** from the **Book** menu:
 - Tap on **Headline** bar or **Menu button** to display the form menu
 - Tap on **Book**
 - Tap on **Reference Resources...**
3. Activate one or more dictionaries:
 - Enable the check box of **Reference Resources**
 - Enable one or more dictionaries



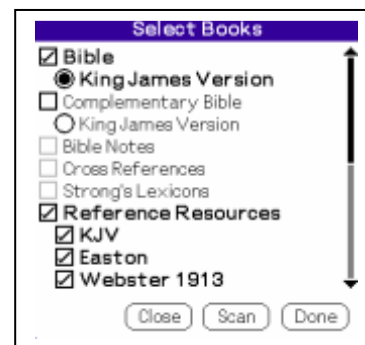
Notes:

If after installing this product, its check box is not active, tap on **Scan** button to refresh information about installed databases.

Bible With You stores cache information about the available databases. This speeds the operation when you use memory cards.

It is not necessary to scan each time. Scan when you:

- Installed new database(s)
- Deleted database(s)
- Transferred database(s) from handheld RAM to memory card or vice versa
- Moved database(s) in another folder of the memory card



4.2 Deactivation

1. Choose **Reference Resources...** from the **Book** menu:
 - Tap on **Headline** bar or **Menu button** to display the form menu
 - Tap on **Book**
 - Tap on **Reference Resources...**
 2. Deactivate dictionaries:
 - Disable the check box of **Reference Resources**
- Or**
- Disable the respective dictionaries

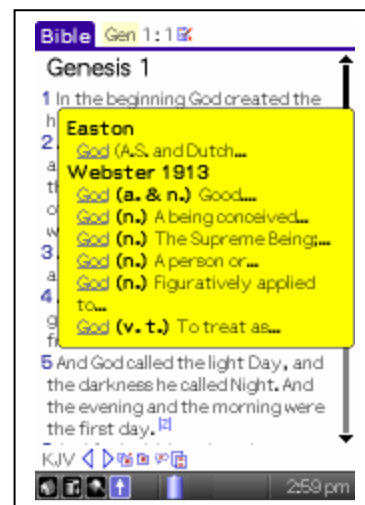
4.3 Viewing the Definitions of Words

Dictionaries With You provide the definitions of words in the Bible, which **Bible With You** displays in pop-up windows. Apart from the words' meaning, the definitions may contain information about the word as what part of the speech it is, cross references to verses in the Bible or references to other words in the dictionary database.

1. Open a pop-up with a word definition
 - Tap on a word in the Bible text and hold the stylus until the pop-up window is displayed

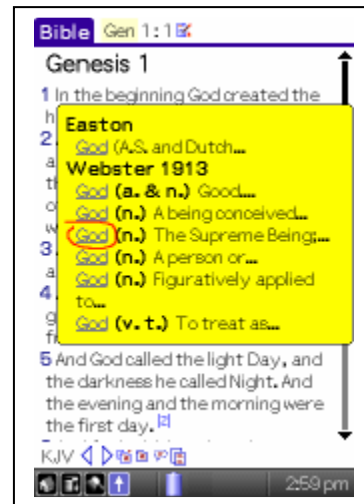
Notes:

1. You need to hold the stylus a little longer than just tap on the screen with it (~ 1/3 sec.)
2. If the word is found in only one of the dictionaries databases, or it has only one meaning, the definition pop-up will show directly the definition.
3. If the word is found in more than one of the dictionaries, and (or) it has several meanings, the definition pop-up will show a list of the different meanings found in each of the active dictionaries.
4. The different meanings of the word are distinguished by a blue color and are underlined (God).



2. View a particular meaning of the word

- Tap on it in the list of word's meanings in the pop-up window



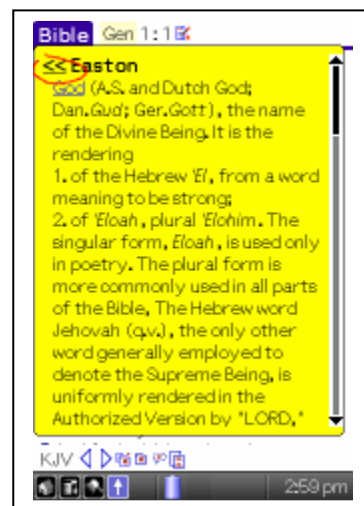
Note: The name of the dictionary in which you read the particular meaning is displayed at the top of the definition pop-up.

3. Move the text within the pop-up

- Tap on the scroll bar within the pop-up with the stylus

4. Return to the list of different meanings of the word

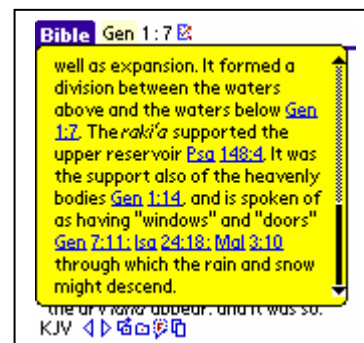
- Tap on the **≤≤** sign before the dictionary name



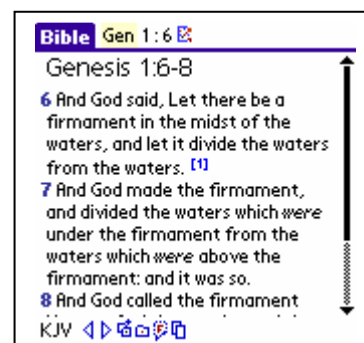
5. View a cross-reference found in the definition

Cross references to Bible verses are indicated by the abbreviation of the Bible book and the numbers of chapter and verse, in blue color, underlined.

- Tap on it in the definition pop-up



The respective verse(s) from the cross reference will be displayed on the screen.



6. Return to the verse, in which you have explored a word's meanings

➤ Tap on the **Headline bar** or the **Menu** button to display the form menu

➤ Tap on **View**

➤ Tap on **Previous**

Or

➤ Draw the **Backspace Graffiti Stroke** on the *silk screen*

Or

➤ Select **Backspace** button in the **Virtual** or the **Hardware** Keyboard

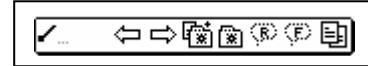
Or

➤ Draw the *Graffiti Menu Command stroke* to display the **command bar**

➤ Tap on the *Back* arrow

Or

➤ Tap on the *Back Arrow* icon in the *Command Toolbar* if it is shown

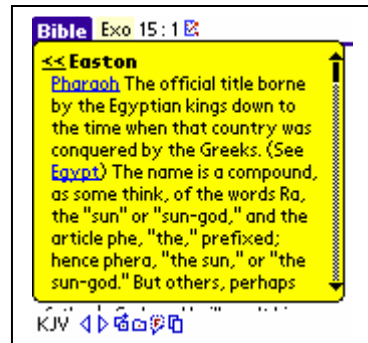


7. View a reference to a word

The word definition may include a reference to another word in the same dictionary. It is indicated by blue color and is underlined.

➤ Tap on a blue, underlined word in the definition

The definition of the referenced word will be displayed in a new pop-up



8. Return to the meaning of the word you are exploring

Tap on the **<<** sign before the dictionary name

9. Return to the Bible text

Tap on the plain text or a blank space within the definition pop-up

Or

Tap on the screen outside the definition pop-up

Dictionary and Encyclopedia Personal Reader is a dictionary program that supports GMPSoft and RefToGo dictionaries, lexicons and reference material such as stats and lists. It provides several search mechanisms besides the standard one that guarantee you'll find a match – Spelling search, Phonetic search and Crossword search.
